## ORDER

The E-Filing System will require attorneys to pay a filing fee for every motion filed with the Court. However, in order to ensure fairness in the collection of our fees, the Court finds that the following uncontested motions are not subject to filing fees.

- Motion to Withdraw Request for Contested Case or Appeal
- Consent Motion for Dismissal (signed by all parties)
- Initial Consent Scheduling Order (amended request requires motion and fee)
- Consent Confidentiality Order
- Consent Order filed resolving a motion for which the fee has been paid.
- Consent Protective Order
